FOR POETRY AND SHORT STORIES IN SPANISH

RULES

- Artes de Mexico en Utah invites high school students and adults whose residence is in the state of Utah to participate, with an unpublished poem or prose written in the Spanish language under the following categories:
 - Category 1 Spanish as a native language
 - Category 2 Spanish as a second language
- One work written per participant will be accepted, with a maximum length of one page, which must be submitted, double-spaced, Arial letter 12 points.
- Participants must fill out the google form provided including name, age, email and address, telephone number, name of the school (if you are a high school student) and city. The poem or prose must be sent as an attachment, do not include your name on the document or any other information that identifies the author.
- The works will be received from the publication of this call and until Monday,
 June 26, 2023.
- Once the jury's decision has been issued, it will be unappealable.
- They will not be able to participate:
 - a) Works that have been awarded in other contests.
 - b) Winners of this prize in the last two contests.
 - c) No person who works in the representing institution.
 - d) Works that have been published by any means.
- The jury will be composed of three poets of recognized trajectory in Utah.
- The winners will receive a cash prize sponsored by Utah Humanities of:

1st place \$250 | 2o Place \$200 | 3rd place \$150 | Honorable Mention

- Winners will have the opportunity to participate in the Utah Arts Festival in 2024 (upon request accepted by the jury of the such festival)
- The winners will transfer the copyright of their work to Artes de México in Utah for a period of one year, they will also give credit to the convening institution in presentations, events, and dissemination of the work.
- The jury's verdict will be announced by email
- The participants accept all the clauses of this call at the time of entering their work to this contest.
- The Organizing Committee will resolve cases not provided for in this call.
