12TH Annual Sor Juana Contest FOR POETRY AND SHORT STORIES IN SPANISH



With the purpose of promoting poetic creation in the Spanishspeaking community, we are pleased to announce the 12th Sor Juana Prize for Poetry and Prose in Spanish, in honor of the distinguished poet Sor Juana Inés de la Cruz.

- Jr. high school and high school students from grades 9th to 12th, and adults whose residence is in the state of Utah may participate with an unpublished poem or prose written in the Spanish language, under the following categories:
 - Category 1: Spanish, as a native language.
 - Category 2: Spanish, as a second language.
- One written work on a free topic will be accepted per participant, which must be presented on one page, double spaced, in 12-point Arial font.
- Fill out the Google form. Include: name, age, email and address, phone number, school name (if student), and city.
- The poem or prose must be sent as an attachment without adding the author's name or other identifying information.
- Writings will be accepted from the publication of this call and until Monday, July 1, 2024.
- Once the jury's decision is issued, it will be final.
- Will not be able to participate:

 - a) Works that have been awarded in other competitions.
 b) People who have won this award in the last two editions of this contest.
 c) No person who works in the organizing institution.
 d) Written works that have been published on social networks.
- The jury will be made up of three poets with recognized trajectory in Utah.
- The winners will receive a cash prize of:

1st place: \$300 | 2nd Place: 200 | 3rd place: 150 | Honorary mentions will have the opportunity to recite their poems

- The winners will also have the opportunity to participate in several art festivals in the state during 2025 (upon application accepted by the festivals)
- The winners will assign the copyright of their work to Artes de México en Utah, and will also give credit to the convening institution in presentations, events and dissemination of the work.
- The jury's verdict will be announced by email.
- Participants accept all the clauses of this call at the time of entering their work in this contest.
- The Organizing Committee will resolve cases not provided for in this call.
